

## KNOWLEDGE TRANSLATION RESEARCH AWARD, 2011

### AWARD

An annual award of \$2,000 is available for registered nurses who are members of the Canadian Pain Society to support a pain-related knowledge translation research project. This award is an Unrestricted Educational Grant. This award is presented at the annual conference during the dinner evening. A complimentary dinner ticket is included.

### APPLICANT

Registered Nurse who has been a member of the Canadian Pain Society for at least one year and not been a recipient of this grant for 3 years.

### REQUIREMENTS

- a. Applicants must submit a two-page written proposal for the use of the money, to include the purpose, objectives, method, evaluation and budget, along with a reference letter from a CPS member.
- b. Project must aim to improve patient outcomes using knowledge translation strategies.
- c. Project must be completed within one year.
- d. Recipient will submit results in abstract form to be considered for poster presentation at the subsequent CPS Scientific meeting. CPS support must be acknowledged on all presentations.
- e. The complete Nomination Package must be received by the CPS no later than **September 30, 2010**.

### SELECTION PROCESS

All submissions will be ranked according to feasibility, methodology, ethical considerations and relevance to current practice issues. The selection will be made by a subcommittee of the CPS SIG-NI appointed by the Chair. All decisions are final.

The deadline for the competition is **SEPTEMBER 30, 2010**.
