

OUTSTANDING PAIN MENTORSHIP AWARD, 2012

Award

\$1,000 plus \$1,500 travel expenses to the CPS Annual Conference, plaque presentation at the annual dinner plus complimentary dinner ticket. In order to receive the \$1,500 travel expense allowance, the award recipient must attend the CPS Conference. Failure to attend the conference will result in the \$1,500 travel expense not being awarded.

Description

This award will be presented annually at the CPS Annual Conference to a researcher and/or clinician who consistently exemplifies outstanding mentorship in the training of future pain researchers and/or clinicians.

Candidate

A member of the Canadian Pain Society for at least 2 years and has not been a previous recipient of this award.

Nomination Requirements

- a. Candidates must be nominated by at least 1 colleague. The person(s) nominating and the nominee must be members of the CPS.
- b. Nominations must be made in writing, and include the nominee's curriculum vitae and a narrative endorsement to a maximum of 750 words (endorsement only) describing the mentorship qualities of the candidate and signed by nominee(s). All submissions must be sent to the CPS office via email for distribution to the CPS for selection.
- c. The complete nomination package must be received by the CPS no later than **October 15, 2011**.
- d. Selection Process: The selection will be made by a committee formed by the Canadian Pain Society.
