The **Distinguished Career Award** recognizes longstanding service in pain research and/or management.

Award

The award will consist of a Keynote Presentation at the CPS annual conference, economy class travel to the CPS conference, taxi fare, accommodation at the conference hotel for two nights, \$500 honorarium, complimentary conference registration and a complimentary dinner ticket for the annual awards evening event where the award will be presented.

Submission

Applicants must be a current member in good standing with the Canadian Pain Society. A letter of nomination signed by three CPS regular members, along with the CV of the nominee shall be submitted to the Secretariat by email. Decisions are made by a CPS awards committee.
