Submission Guidelines

All abstracts must be submitted through the CPS website. CPS members and non-members are eligible to submit their work as a late breaking poster presentation. Notification regarding the acceptance of abstracts will be conveyed to submitting authors by March 12, 2021, before the early bird conference registration deadline.

Canadian Journal of Pain

Accepted abstracts will be printed in the online *Canadian Journal of Pain*, published by Taylor and Francis, and will be available for online viewing at the 2021 Annual Scientific Meeting. The Journal may not consider your abstract for publication if information from the abstract template is missing.

Submission deadline: **February 26th, 2021**

Description: Posters can include summaries of the results of any research study (quantitative or qualitative) in the area of pain. While the results of pilot studies and abstracts with preliminary results will be considered, abstracts without any data and/or proposals will generally not be deemed suitable for acceptance.
