DESCRIPTION

The **Distinguished Service Award** honors outstanding and dedicated service to the Canadian Pain Society. Examples of outstanding service may include, but are not limited to, contributions to the Board of Directors, CPS Committees (i.e. scientific program, awards), developing a new Special Interest Group, or the development of new initiatives within the Society. The selection will be made by a committee formed by the Canadian Pain Society.

AWARD

The award will consist of:

- \$500.00 honorarium
- Plaque
- Complimentary three-day (3) 2022 Scientific Meeting registration
- Complimentary ticket to the Gala dinner*, where the award will be presented

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- Nominee must be a current member in good standing with the Canadian Pain Society
- A letter of nomination, in English or French, signed by three CPS regular members and should clearly summarize the nominee's service contributions to the Canadian Pain Society.
- CV of the nominee

The Canadian Pain Society is strongly committed to diversity within its membership. Diversity strengthens both research and clinical practice in pain. We encourage nominations by and for racialized persons, Black, Indigenous and people of colour, women, LGBTQ2S+, persons with disabilities, and others who bring diverse perspectives to the field of pain.
