DESCRIPTION

The **Early Career Award** recognizes outstanding achievements in pain research and/or management by an individual at the early stage of his or her career. The selection will be made by a committee formed by the Canadian Pain Society.

AWARD

The award will consist of:

- Keynote Presentation at the 2022 CPS Annual Scientific Meeting (May 10-13, 2022, in Montreal)
- Economy class travel to the CPS Annual Scientific Meeting (up to \$1000.00)
- Taxi fare and incidentals (up to \$100.00)
- Two (2) nights' accommodation at the Scientific Meeting hotel
- \$250.00 honorarium
- Plaque
- Complimentary three-day (3) 2022 Scientific Meeting registration
- Complimentary ticket to the Gala dinner*, where the award will be presented

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- Nominees must hold a PhD or MD degree (or equivalent) and hold an independent research and/or clinical appointment. Applicants must be within 8 years of their independent appointment at a Canadian University or affiliated research institution at the time of application. Interruptions and delays in career will be considered when determining eligibility.
- Nominees must be current members in good standing with the Canadian Pain Society
- A letter of nomination, in English or French, signed by three CPS regular members
- CV of the nominee

The Canadian Pain Society is strongly committed to diversity within its membership. Diversity strengthens both research and clinical practice in pain. We encourage nominations by and for racialized persons, Black, Indigenous and people of colour, women, LGBTQ2S+, persons with disabilities, and others who bring diverse perspectives to the field of pain.
