DESCRIPTION

The **Outstanding Pain Mentorship Award** will be presented annually at the CPS Annual Scientific Meeting to a researcher and/or clinician who consistently exemplifies outstanding mentorship in the training of future pain researchers and/or clinicians. The selection will be made by a committee formed by the Canadian Pain Society.

AWARD

The award will consist of:

- \$250.00 honorarium
- Plaque
- Complimentary three-day (3) 2022 Scientific Meeting registration
- Complimentary ticket to the Gala dinner*, where the award will be presented

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- Candidates must be nominated by at least 1 colleague or current/former trainee
- The person(s) nominating and the nominee must be current members in good standing with the Canadian Pain Society
- Nomination letter, in English or French, (max 2 pages) describing the mentorship qualities of the candidate
- Nominee's curriculum vitae

The Canadian Pain Society is strongly committed to diversity within its membership. Diversity strengthens both research and clinical practice in pain. We encourage nominations by and for racialized persons, Black, Indigenous and people of colour, women, LGBTQ2S+, persons with disabilities, and others who bring diverse perspectives to the field of pain.
