

PAIN AWARENESS AWARD 2022

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

DESCRIPTION

The Canadian Pain Society (CPS) presents the **Pain Awareness Award** to the candidate(s) with the Best Pain Awareness Project. The goals of the award are to raise awareness of the problem of undermanaged pain in Canada, to highlight efforts towards finding solutions to the problem, and to reach a wide Canadian audience. The selection will be made by a committee formed by the Canadian Pain Society.

AWARD

The award consists of:

- Plaque
- Complimentary three-day (3) 2022 Scientific Meeting registration
- Complimentary ticket to the Gala dinner*, where the award will be presented

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- One (1) page brief description of candidate's project, in English or French, including impact on target audience (max 1 page)
- Projects involving electronic or printed media, visual, fine arts, dance, music or other creative expressions will be considered. If you wish to submit an extra item to support the project (e.g. DVD, CD, book) please send (3) copies. The CPS encourages projects using several forms of expression and group submissions and submissions from different backgrounds and disciplines are preferred (i.e. projects combining science and art, collaborations between persons living with pain and health care providers).
- The recipient(s) will be invited to present their project at the 2022 Annual Scientific Meeting. The format of the presentation (e.g. poster, concurrent session, display table) will be determined by the awardee in collaboration with the Scientific Program Committee. The CPS may seek permissions to reproduce the work to continue raising awareness.

The Canadian Pain Society is strongly committed to diversity within its membership. Diversity strengthens both research and clinical practice in pain. We encourage submissions from racialized persons, Black, Indigenous and people of colour, women, LGBTQ2S+, persons with disabilities, and others who bring diverse perspectives to the field of pain.

FORMAT

All documents must be combined and uploaded into one PDF file that is no larger than 30 MB.
